

EQUINE INFLUENZA

Contagious viral disease of the respiratory tract

Clinical Signs

- Harsh dry cough
- Fever of 38.5 C – 43 C
- Nasal discharge – clear/yellow
- Depression
- Reduced appetite

Vaccination

Highly recommended and mandatory if competing under Jockey Club, FEI, BS, BD, BE and pony/riding club rules

- Primary Course: 2 injections no less than 21 and no more than 60 days apart.
- First booster: 120 – 180 days after the second vaccination in the primary course.
- Subsequent boosters: No more than 365 days after the first booster.

Note: Some competing bodies require booster at 6 monthly intervals
