#### **Christmas Charity—Redwings!**

This festive season we are hoping to give a little help to our friends at Redwings Horse Sanctuary — Ada Cole. Their incredible rescue teams work tirelessly to save horses and ponies in need of our help

Redwings began with the rescue of a single pony, Sheba. Her recovery inspired the formation of a sanctuary in 1984 dedicated to saving horses from a life of fear and neglect.

From that one life saved, they have grown to become the largest horse welfare charity in the UK, caring for more than 1,500 horses, ponies, donkeys and mules every day sanctuary sites in England and Scotland.

Redwings have 500 horses living in Guardian homes through their rehoming programme and a specialist behaviour team to work with those who may have not had the best training or start in life.



## Winter Worries: Respiratory Health

Over the winter, horses tend to be stabled for much longer. This can leave to increased exposure to environmental airway irritants, which can then trigger respiratory issues such as coughing and asthma attacks.

## There are some simple things you can do to reduce these problems:

Ensure there is good air hygiene—make sure ventilation is good by keeping windows open

Turn your horse out

Soak hay prior to feeding to reduce the dust levels

Avoid bonfires nearby
